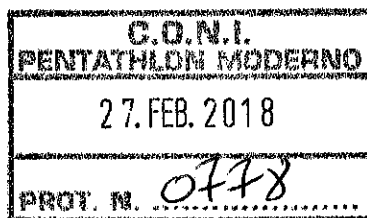
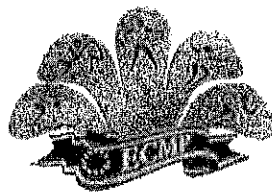


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**EUROPEAN CUP & BOYS AND GIRL U19 YOG RANKING COMPETITION

Pazardzhik, Bulgaria, 2-3 June 2018**

INVITATION LETTER

Dear Friends,

The Bulgarian Modern Pentathlon Federation has the pleasure to invite a delegation of your country to participate in the "**HRISTO CHOCHEV MEMORIAL**" boys and girls U 19 YOG ranking competition from 2 to 3 June 2018 in Pazardzhik, Bulgaria.

THE PROGRAMME:

31 May/1 June 2018	Arrival Technical Meeting at 8:00 p.m.
2 June 2018	Fencing /Boys and Girls/
3 June 2018	Laser Run /Boys and Girls/
4 June 2018	Departure

ECONOMICAL CONDITIONS

All participants will be accommodated at Jor-Daniel Hotel in Pazardzhik.

Please note on the Entry Form A your choice of rooms. The following price includes full board, accommodation, local transportation and entry to the competition. The cost of stay per person per night is:

Delegations are required to send by bank transfer of 30% deposit or 100% of full amount per person with Entry Form B. The remaining amount has to be paid in cash at the accreditation desk on arrival, where it will be given an Invoice of the total cost of stay for your Delegation.

Nations wishing to arrange their own accommodation must pay accreditation fee per participant (athletes, coaches and officials) 50 Euro per day (minimum 2 days). The accreditation Fee must be paid by bank transfer with the Final Entry Form. For this, we will provide lunch packets for the competition days and allow access to official transportation between the official hotel and competition sites.

REMARKS:

Delegations are reminded of the Rule 1.14.3 and 1.14.5. Following confirmation of the final entries, a NF must enter the competition with at least one pentathlete. Any NF failing to take part after having sent their final entries will pay a fine of 600 Euros to UIPM.

If, on arrival for the competition, the team has less athletes and/or officials than listed on their Final Entry Form C and without informing the Organizing Nation/LOC at least 7 days prior to their arrival, the NF will pay a fine to the Organizing Nation/LOC of 200 Euro for each person.

RULES

The competition will be carried out according to the UIPM Rules.

Swimming: 25m indoor swimming pool / 5 lanes;

Fencing: 9 pistes;

Laser Run: 36+2 laser targets will be used

ENTRIES

The U19 Tetrathlon competition will count towards Youth Olympic Games World Ranking List (YOGPWR) U19 (YA), for athletes born 2000-2003 – If fulfilling criteria according to UIPM Competition Rule 1.19.2

For the U19 Tetrathlon competition the maximum number allowed is 4 athletes per nation and gender. The host nation can compete with 6 athletes per gender UIPM Competition rules 1.12.8

ATHLETES' LICENSE

Athletes are only allowed to participate in UIPM sanctioned events, if they are registered with the UIPM.

TRAINING

The LOC will offer training facilities for swimming.

EQUIPMENT CONTROL

The equipment control for fencing will be immediately before the first round of fencing and for laser run with take part prior the beginning of the competition.

TRANSPORTATION PLAN

The price include local transport from Sofia Airport to the hotel and the return journey, but it is only guaranteed if flight information is provided in good time, as according to the deadline on Entry Form C. Transportation from the hotel to the venue for athletes will be according to the training and competition program.

VISAS

Visiting nations should confirm visa requirements for entry in to Bulgaria prior travelling to the event. The LOC cannot accept responsibility for arranging visas, but can provide specific letters of invitation if needed. For information, if you need a visa please contact your nearest Bulgarian Embassy or Consulate.

INSURANCE

All members of the attending Delegations must insure themselves in case of accidental injury or illness. The organizer will not accept any responsibility financial or otherwise for loss, injury or illness of any Delegation member.

FIREARMS

Firearms Licenses are not a legal requirement when bringing air and CO2 pistols into Bulgaria for competition purposes.

GENERAL INFORMATION

All athletes are kindly requested to wear their official national uniform at the competition. Please also bring a CD with your national anthem and a national flag.
Weather conditions: approximately **21-28 Degree C.**
