## International German Laser Run Championships

Saturday, August 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020, Nuremberg, Germany

Dear Friends,

The DVMF – Deutscher Verband für Modernen Fünfkampf e.V., together with the Modern Pentathlon section of sports club TSV Katzwang e.V., has the pleasure of inviting a delegation of your country to participate in the DVMF International German Laser Run Championships to be held in Nuremberg, Bavaria, Germany, on August 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020 according to the following program and rules:

**Competition Venues:** Stadium of Bertolt Brecht School, Bertolt-Brecht-Str. 39, 90471 Nürnberg, Germany

**Competition Rules:** The competition will be carried out according to the DVMF Competition Rules of Laser-Run (<https://www.laser-run.de/site/rules>).

Running: Tartan track, pavement.

Shooting: 12 + 1 reserve lane with Pentashot Hit&Miss targets for the competition  
12 shooting lanes in the warm up area

Note:

- The competition will be organized in the Elite and in the Open Category
- Categories and distances will follow UIPM rules (<https://www.laser-run.de/site/rules>)
- Laser shooting is strictly restricted to the competition shooting lanes and the warm up shooting lanes – no practicing elsewhere within the stadium!

**Competition Categories & Age Groups:** Elite Category: U9 to Masters 60+ (Individual) and U9 to Masters 60+ (Mixed Relay)  
Open Category: U9 to Masters 60+ (Individual) and U9 to Masters 60+ (Mixed Relay)

**Athletes:** For the Elite classification, athletes need an official license number of UIPM or must be a member of any sport club that is registered in the DOSB.

All other athletes will be ranked in the open division.

It is the responsibility of every athlete to be in adequate health condition. Athletes under the age of 18 need a certificate of health (dated no longer than 1 year ago).

**Rankings:** There will be a German ranking and an international one for all age groups in both classifications.

Only Germans participating in the Elite category can become **German Champion** (or be placed second and third) for the individual and **German Champion Relay** for the relay event. German participants of the Open category can become **Open Champion** and **Open Champion Relay**.

Winners of the international ranking will be declared as **Winner of the International German Championship** and **Winner of the International German Championship Relay**.

Every Relay Team gets placed in the more powerful age group of the two relay athletes.

**Qualification for finals:** Qualification heats for the finals may be held if more than 12 participants are registered for an age group according to the DVMF rules of Laser-Run.

- Registration:** The respective sport club registers its athletes at [www.Laser-Run.de](http://www.Laser-Run.de) for the Elite Category. A registration on the website may be necessary. Athletes of the Open Category can register themselves.  
Access to the competition will be strictly regulated. To get access to the competition site every athlete, coach, official and everybody else including relatives and friends who travel with the athlete need to register themselves at the above mentioned website. Confirmations will be sent via Email and need be printed out and brought to the competition site to gain access.
- Deadlines:** Wednesday, 29th July 2020. Reduced entry fees if registered until Friday, 17<sup>th</sup> July 2020.
- Entry Fees:** 20 € per person for individual event, 20 € per relay (10 € per person) when registered until 17<sup>th</sup> July 2020; after the 17<sup>th</sup> July 2020 25 € per person for individual event and 25 € per relay.
- Insurance:** The organizer will not accept any financial liability for loss, injury or illness occurred to any participant and or member of delegation.

|       | The order of heats is dependent on the number of registrations for each age group. The individual heats will be first, followed by the relay heats. Qualification heats (if necessary) will be held at least two hours before the respective final takes place. |

- The final competition program will be published at [www.Laser-Run.de](http://www.Laser-Run.de) on the 30<sup>th</sup> July 2020.
- Hygiene Regulation:** Only registered persons will get access to the competition site, as stated above. The accreditation card handed out at the entrance must be worn so that it can be seen at all times. Only athletes are allowed to put it down for the duration of their heats. Social distancing of at least 1.5 metres must be maintained at all times and masks that cover mouth and nose must be worn when walking around at the competition site. Athletes do not need to wear masks during their heat. The conditions in the “Rahmenhygienekonzept Sport” of the Bavarian Home Office are to be observed in the version valid at the date of competition. All heats will be contactless. Any deliberate or approved contact will lead to disqualification. Relays will be contactless.
- General Information:** Food and drinks can be bought at a food station on the competition site organised by an external service provider.
- Accommodation:** All athletes and members of attending delegations are responsible for booking their own accommodation. A list of recommended accommodations can be found soon at [www.Laser-Run.de](http://www.Laser-Run.de).
- Visas & Vaccinations:** Visiting nations should confirm visa and vaccination requirements for entry into Germany prior travelling to the event. We cannot accept responsibility for arranging visas but can provide specific letters of invitation if needed. For information regarding visas or vaccinations please contact your nearest Embassy or Consulate.
